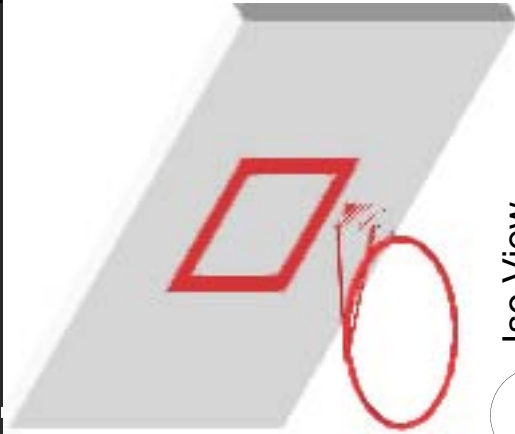
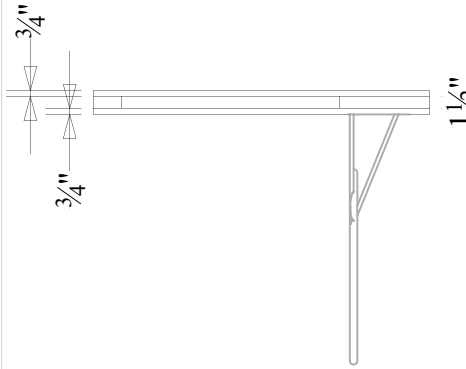
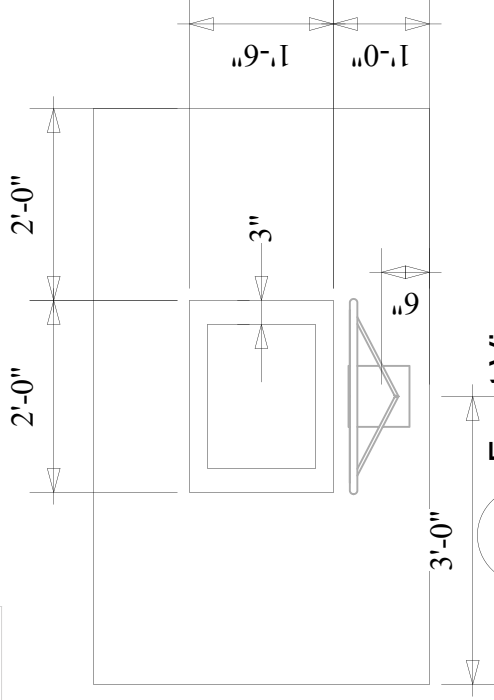




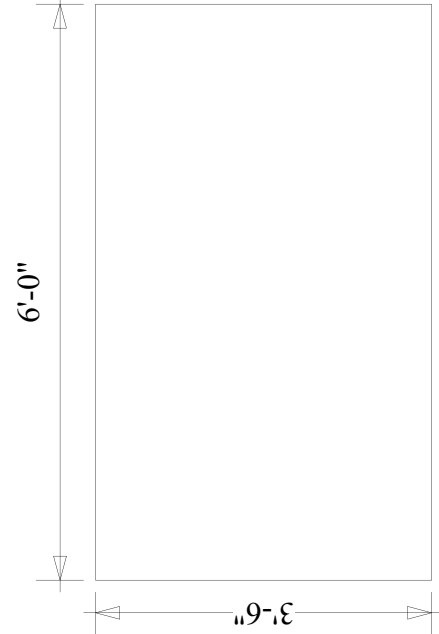
1 Iso View

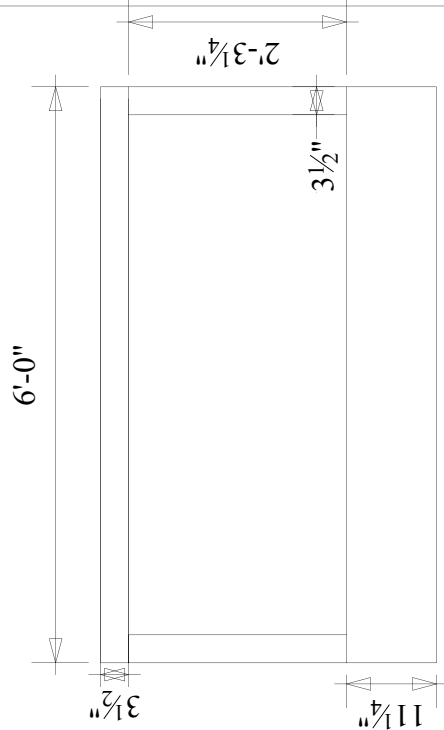
2 Side View

Instructions. Step 1: Cut Lumber

Step 2: Draw on outline for backboard square and mark holes for hoop on front piece of 3/4" plywood.

Step 3: Attach basketball hoop with 3/8" carriage bolts with bolt sticking through towards the hoop.

Step 4: Screw and glue backboard to the 2x4 and 2x12 pieces with 1-5/8" screws.

Step 5: Attach hanging hardware and groove out area for 1/8" hanging lines.
Step 6: Attach back piece of 3/4" plywood after flow.
